ARTICLE REVIEW PROCESS

Between 12th January and 23rd January, 2026, the Board will be reviewing all submissions and ensuring that they are up-to-standard for publication.

During this time, they may make some minor edits or will provide the authors with suggestions/feedback on edits to be made before publication. Therefore, authors must be responsive during this time in order for their paper to be approved for publication.

The Board will stay in close-communication with the authors throughout this period of time, keeping them updated on the status of their article submission.

- Strength of Voice

1500-2000 words

Citations:

Follows the style of APA 7th Edition.

Unacknowledged use of others' work will result in disqualification. AI tools may assist, but all content and analysis must be the author's own.
