

# MADE Representatives Document

## **What do you do?**

As a MADE Representative, you will be responsible for the promotion of MADE events and initiatives to your school under the guidance of your State Delegate.

In addition, you are tasked with organising your own initiatives within your school that support MADE's mission by getting more students interested in studying Economics and in engaging with the field more deeply. For example, this may involve getting an Economics professional as a speaker for a school assembly or setting up The Young Economist's Society.

Finally, MADE Representatives should also remain on the lookout for students from other schools who are interested in studying Economics and recommend them to the appropriate state delegate. This method will allow for the MADE Representatives network to continue growing.

If a MADE Representative reaches their final year of high school, it is imperative that they select their successor and prepare them to take over the role in the next year.

## **Future Pathways**

The MADE Committee is a group of 24 members with different roles and responsibilities who work together to plan and execute MADE's overall strategy in fulfilling its mission.

The selection of MADE Committee members are done through the MADE Representatives network. Therefore, all MADE Representatives will be given the fair opportunity to apply for positions in the MADE Committee (with performance as a MADE Representative being an important factor in selection). Large-scale recruiting and training for the MADE Committee typically occur during the first term of every school year, although there may be openings in various positions throughout the course of the year.
